Message from Alain Roux

Updated Wednesday 19th May 2021

If you have a reservation with us between Wednesday 19th May and Sunday 20th June inclusive, may we remind you that we must adhere to the 'rule of 6', which means parties can be made up of a maximum of six people from different households. We would ask that you help us to follow and abide by these rules for your own safety as well as our staff's well-being.

We will still be respecting the Government guidance on 'hands, face, space' until otherwise advised. All of our staff are being tested twice a week and are required to report their results to our administration and to the NHS. Anyone testing positive will be asked to remain at home and self-isolate.

From 29 Mar 2021, to support NHS Test and Trace, all visitors above the age of 16 are required to 'check in' at hospitality venues, not just one person per group.

This can be done on arrival at Roux at Skindles via our NHS QR code poster with the NHS COVID-19 phone app, or by providing your name and contact details prior to, or on arrival. We are legally required to collect this information and anyone not wishing to comply, will unfortunately be refused entry.

Data will be stored and used in compliance with the relevant data protection legislation. It will be held for 21 days from the date of your visit before secure disposal or deletion. Your personal information will only be shared with NHS Test and Trace if a request is made by them. The information we collect will not be used for any other purpose.
